

Peppo and Jane Biscarini

Greetings from sunny Florida; we pray the unsurpassing peace & joy of our Lord may reign in your hearts. Two weeks ago I sent an update to those of you that provided us with an e-mail address. If you did not receive it, please email us at agapexec@libero.it so that we may include you on the list. What we have experienced thus far during our Executive Ministries training is definitely better than what we anticipated.

How does it work? Typically a committed host couple, with the ability to sponsor formal dinner events, would work in conjunction with an Executive Ministry team in their local area to reach influencers who have not been exposed to the gospel.

- Invitations are sent to specific neighborhoods near the host couples residence. (see attached profile of the speakers)
- The dinner speaker is generally sharing his personal testimony and offering an invitation to receive Christ at closing. Response cards are filled out and have three options:
 1. Received Christ for the first time
 2. Would like to attend a Bible Study
 3. Would like more information.

(During these events 122 came to the Lord for the first time. Praise God!)

- A personal follow up begins one weeks after the event. Up until now Jane and I were not too familiar with the mechanics and results of aggressive evangelism, but we are now sold to its effectiveness.
- During the one-on-one we use the 4 Spiritual Laws booklets (though I am not the booklet type) to stay focused and solicit a genuine response. We then encourage these people to attend one of our Bible Studies (we offer one for women, one for men and one for anybody- total attendees 200-210) and see them grow. I have the privilege of teaching a few of those studies and feel richly blessed (will send some of those tapes to our team partners). Our last new believers series started on April 4 and will end 4/25; please pray that these new converts will get firmly planted in the gospel and continue with the other studies.

Jane shared her testimony at the ladies study and led some of the small groups. She is impressed with the dedication of the women's leadership team comprising 15 believers who came to Christ and were disciplined through this ministry.

Duplicating this in Italy will be quite a challenge, but we serve the God of the impossible.

- The Lord to raise a host couple/couples in Italy and reveal to us which city we should relocate to.
- Another Italian speaking couple to assist us in the ministry.
- Changed lives on May 18. Jane and I are invited by one of our supporters to speak at a businessmen dinner in Dallas, TX.

***A little bit of laughter:**” I have had 2 By-Pass surgeries, a hip replacement and fought prostate cancer, and diabetes. I take 20 different medications that make me dizzy, winded, and subject to blackouts. Have bouts with dementia, poor circulation, hardly feel my hands & feet anymore, can’t remember if I’m 80 or 85, have lost most of my friends, but...thank God I still have my DRIVERS LICENSE! Isn’t it great to live in Palm Beach”.*

Unfortunately this is no joke , but a scary reality in this town....

Upon completion she exits the clinic and a car runs over her killing her.
